Phillips Pipe Line Company maintains two **active** pipelines at this location.

Location: Township 44 North, Range 10 West, Sections 28 and 33, Cole and Osage Co's., Missouri.

Size, Date, and Method of Abandonment :

1. An 8" line designated as the "A" Line was installed in 1930 until 1942. In 1942, this line was transferred to the "B" Line. In 1956, this line was transferred to the "A-Loop" and was abandoned in 1958. The line was cut and capped.
2. A 12" Line designated as the "B" Line was installed in 1956 and was abandoned in 1988. The line was purged of product and the line was cut and capped.
3. An 8" Line designated as the "A" Line was installed in 1958 and was abandoned in 1973. The line was cut and capped.
4. An 8" Line designated as the "A-Loop" was installed in 1958. In 1973, this line was transferred to the "A" Line and was abandoned in 1988. The line was purged of product and the line was cut and capped.

Size, Date, and Method of Abandonment :

1. An 8" line designated as the original "B" Line was installed in 1930 and was abandoned in 1943. The line was cut and capped.
2. An 8" Line designated as the "A" Line was installed in 1943 and abandoned in 1987. The line was purged of product and then cut and capped.
3. An 8" designated as the "B" Line was installed in 1943 and was transferred to propane in 1962. It was abandoned in 1987. The line was purged of product and then cut and capped.
4. A 10" Line designated as the "B" Line was installed in 1962 and abandoned in 1987. The line was purged of product and then cut and capped.



Phillips Pipe Line Company maintains five **active** lines at this location.

Location: Brazoria County, Texas, S. F. Austin Survey, A-37 on the east side of the Bayou and S. & G. Angier Survey, A-6 on the west side.

Size, Date, and Method of Abandonment :

An 8" Crude Line was installed in 1950. The line (36.98 miles) was idled in March, 1994, and then abandoned in 1998. The line was pigged with water, followed with nitrogen, and then blinded at both ends of the line.
